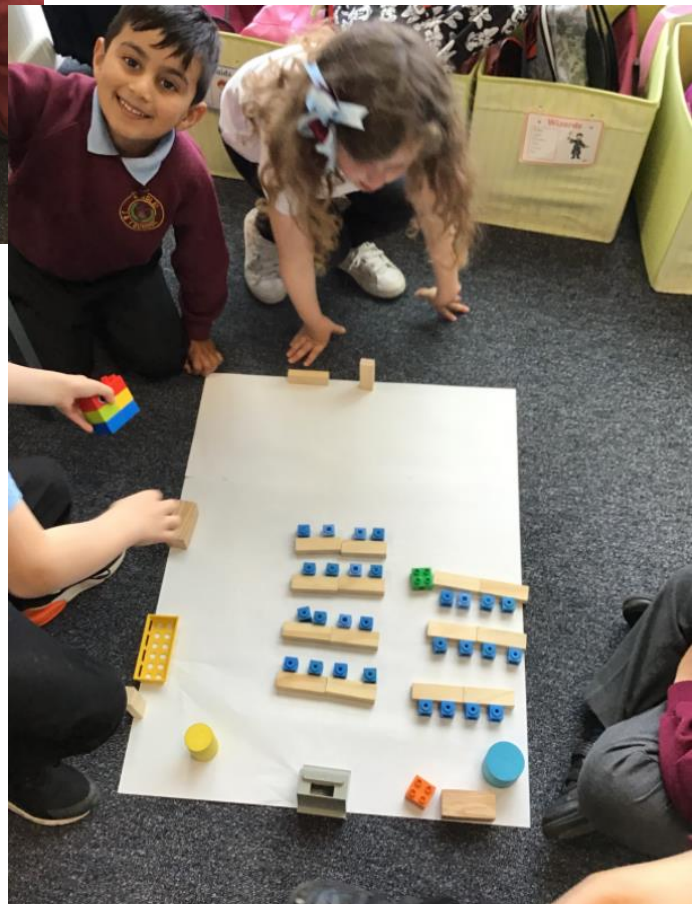
Summer 1 - 2021

Topic - Our School

They found out that some countries have trade deals, that some can easily grow certain kinds of products (France can grow grapes, Ireland can grow potatoes) etc due to the climate of the countries.

We also learned that for the UK, the vast majority of things that we export are services such as banking and even teaching!
