

Home Learning Ideas



What will you choose to do this half term?

- Draw a picture of one of your friends and talk about why they are your friend – what is it you like about them? You could bring it into school and talk about your friend with the class.
- Think about ways you can make a friend smile – you could make a card for them, say something nice, play with them or share a book with them. Talk about how you made them smile.
- Tell an adult at home all the things that friends do to make you smile and make you happy. Tell them about your school day and what made you smile today.
- As part of our topic we will be learning about how people help us. For example, fire fighters and police officers. Can you make a 3D fire engine or police car at home using junk modelling materials (empty cereal boxes, tubes etc)? Bring it into school and tell us how you made it. We will display it on the shelf in the corridor so everyone can see it.
- Do things at home to help your family. You could draw a picture of something you have done to help someone, or you could send a photo into school via Class Dojo.
- Have you got a story book at home about friends? You could share it with an adult at home. Talk about the nice things that the friends in the story do for one another. Think about the ways in which we can make new friends.
- Make a friend or a family member a friendship bracelet. You could use wool or paper. What colours will you use? Who will you give it to?
