Friday 7th December

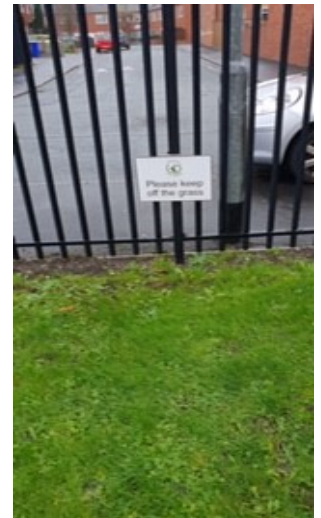
EYFS: Chocolate
